Sunday - Day 1 before Shabbat - Parasha Nitzavim-Vayeilech - You Are Standing - And He Went.

Deuteronomy 29:10-to-end. (JPS=Deuteronomy 29:9-28).

- 10 You stand this day all of you before YAHWEH your ELOHIM; your heads, your tribes, your elders, and your officers, even all the men of Israel,
- 11 your little ones, your wives, and your foreigner who is in the midst of your camps, from the one who cuts your wood to the one who draws your water;
- 12 that you may enter into the covenant of YAHWEH your ELOHIM, and into his oath, which YAHWEH your ELOHIM makes with you this day;
- 13 that he may establish you this day to himself for a people, and that he may be to you an ELOHIM, as he spoke to you, and as he swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob.
- 14 Neither with you only do I make this covenant and this oath,
- 15 but with him who stands here with us this day before YAHWEH our ELOHIM, and also with him who is not here with us this day
- 16 (for you know how we lived in the land of Egypt, and how we came through the midst of the nations through which you passed;
- 17 and you have seen their abominations, and their idols, wood and stone, silver and gold, which were among them);
- 18 lest there should be among you man, or woman, or family, or tribe, whose heart turns away this day from YAHWEH our ELOHIM, to go to serve the gods of those nations; lest there should be among you a root that bears gall and wormwood;
- 19 and it happen, when he hears the words of this curse, that he bless himself in his heart, saying, "I shall have peace, though I walk in the stubbornness of my heart, to destroy the moist with the dry."
- 20 YAHWEH will not pardon him, but then the anger of YAHWEH and his jealousy will smoke against that man, and all the curse that is written in this book shall lie on him, and YAHWEH will blot out his name from under the sky.
- 21 YAHWEH will set him apart to evil out of all the tribes of Israel, according to all the curses of the covenant that is written in this scroll of the Torah.
- 22 The generation to come, your children who shall rise up after you, and the foreigner who shall come from a far land, shall say, when they see the plagues of that land, and the sicknesses with which YAHWEH has made it sick;
- 23 and that the whole land of it is sulfur, salt, and burning, that it is not sown, nor bears, nor any grass grows therein, like the overthrow of Sodom and Gomorrah, Admah and Zeboiim, which YAHWEH overthrew in his anger, and in his wrath:
- 24 even all the nations shall say, "Why has YAHWEH done thus to this land? What does the heat of this great anger mean?"
- 25 Then men shall say, "Because they for sook the covenant of YAHWEH, the ELOHIM of their fathers, which he made with them when he brought them forth out of the land of Egypt,
- 26 and went and served other gods, and worshiped them, gods that they didn't know, and that he had not given to them:
- 27 therefore the anger of YAHWEH was kindled against this land, to bring on it all the curse that is written in this book;
- 28 and YAHWEH rooted them out of their land in anger, and in wrath, and in great indignation, and cast them into another land, as at this day."
- 29 The secret things belong to YAHWEH our ELOHIM; but the things that are revealed

belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this Torah (teaching and instruction).

Monday - Day 2 before Shabbat - Parasha Nitzavim-Vayeilech - You Are Standing - And He Went.

Deuteronomy 30.,31:1-30.

. The Blessing of Returning to ELOHIM. .

It shall happen, when all these things have come on you, the blessing and the curse, which I have set before you, and you shall call them to mind among all the nations, where YAHWEH your ELOHIM has driven you,

- 2 and shall return to YAHWEH your ELOHIM, and shall obey his voice according to all that I command you this day, you and your children, with all your heart, and with all your soul:
- 3 that then YAHWEH your ELOHIM will turn your captivity, and have compassion on you, and will return and gather you from all the peoples, where YAHWEH your ELOHIM has scattered you.
- 4 If your outcasts are in the uttermost parts of the heavens, from there will YAHWEH your ELOHIM gather you, and from there he will bring you back:
- 5 and YAHWEH your ELOHIM will bring you into the land which your fathers possessed, and you shall possess it; and he will do you good, and multiply you above your fathers.
- 6 YAHWEH your ELOHIM will circumcise your heart, and the heart of your seed, to love YAHWEH your ELOHIM with all your heart, and with all your soul, that you may live.
- 7 YAHWEH your ELOHIM will put all these curses on your enemies, and on those who hate you, who persecuted you.
- 8 You shall return and obey the voice of YAHWEH, and do all his commandments which I command you this day.
- 9 YAHWEH your ELOHIM will make you plenteous in all the work of your hand, in the fruit of your body, and in the fruit of your livestock, and in the fruit of your ground, for good: for YAHWEH will again rejoice over you for good, as he rejoiced over your fathers; 10 if you shall obey the voice of YAHWEH your ELOHIM, to keep his commandments and his statutes which are written in this scroll of the Torah; if you turn to YAHWEH your ELOHIM with all your heart, and with all your soul.

11 . The Choice of Life or Death. .

For this commandment which I command you this day, it is not too hard for you, neither is it far off.

- 12 It is not in heaven, that you should say, "Who shall go up for us to heaven, and bring it to us, and make us to hear it, that we may do it?"
- 13 Neither is it beyond the sea, that you should say, "Who shall go over the sea for us, and bring it to us, and make us to hear it, that we may do it?"
- 14 But the word is very near to you, in your mouth, and in your heart, that you may do it.
- 15 Behold, I have set before you this day life and good, and death and evil;
- 16 in that I command you this day to love YAHWEH your ELOHIM, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his ordinances, that you may live and multiply, and that YAHWEH your ELOHIM may bless you in the land where you go in to possess it.
- 17 But if your heart turns away, and you will not hear, but shall be drawn away, and worship other gods, and serve them;
- 18 I denounce to you this day, that you shall surely perish; you shall not prolong your days in the land, where you pass over the Jordan to go in to possess it.
- 19 I call heaven and earth to witness against you this day, that I have set before you life

and death, the blessing and the curse: therefore choose life, that you may live, you and your seed;

20 to love YAHWEH your ELOHIM, to obey his voice, and to cling to him; for he is your life, and the length of your days; that you may dwell in the land which YAHWEH swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them.

. Joshua the New Leader of Israel. .

Moses went and spoke these words to all Israel.

- 2 He said to them, "I am one hundred twenty years old this day; I can no more go out and come in: and YAHWEH has said to me, 'You shall not go over this Jordan.'
- 3 YAHWEH your ELOHIM, he will go over before you; he will destroy these nations from before you, and you shall dispossess them. Joshua shall go over before you, as YAHWEH has spoken.
- 4 YAHWEH will do to them as he did to Sihon and to Og, the kings of the Amorites, and to their land; whom he destroyed.
- 5 YAHWEH will deliver them up before you, and you shall do to them according to all the commandment which I have commanded you.
- 6 Be strong and courageous, don't be afraid, nor be scared of them: for YAHWEH your ELOHIM, he it is who does go with you; he will not fail you, nor forsake you."
- 7 Moses called to Joshua, and said to him in the sight of all Israel, "Be strong and courageous: for you shall go with this people into the land which YAHWEH has sworn to their fathers to give them; and you shall cause them to inherit it.
- 8 YAHWEH, he it is who does go before you; he will be with you, he will not fail you, neither forsake you: don't be afraid, neither be dismayed."

9 . The Torah to Be Read Every Seven Years. .

Moses wrote this Torah (teaching and instruction), and delivered it to the priests the sons of Levi, who bore the ark of the covenant of YAHWEH, and to all the elders of Israel.

- 10 Moses commanded them, saying, "At the end of every seven years, in the set time of the year of release, in the feast of booths,
- 11 when all Israel has come to appear before YAHWEH your ELOHIM in the place which he shall choose, you shall read this Torah (teaching and instruction) before all Israel in their hearing.
- 12 Assemble the people, the men and the women and the little ones, and your foreigner who is within your gates, that they may hear, and that they may learn, and fear YAHWEH your ELOHIM, and observe to do all the words of this Torah (teaching and instruction):
- 13 and that their children, who have not known, may hear, and learn to fear YAHWEH your ELOHIM, as long as you live in the land where you go over the Jordan to possess it."

. Prediction of Israel's Rebellion. .

YAHWEH said to Moses, "Behold, your days approach that you must die: call Joshua, and present yourselves in the Tent of Meeting, that I may commission him." Moses and Joshua went, and presented themselves in the Tent of Meeting.

- 15 YAHWEH appeared in the Tent in a pillar of cloud: and the pillar of cloud stood over the door of the Tent.
- 16 YAHWEH said to Moses, "Behold, you shall sleep with your fathers; and this people will rise up, and play the prostitute after the strange gods of the land, where they go to be

among them, and will forsake me, and break my covenant which I have made with them. 17 Then my anger shall be kindled against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and I will hide my face from them, and they shall be devoured, and many evils and troubles shall come on them; so that they will say in that day, 'Haven't these evils come on us because our ELOHIM is not among us?'

- 18 I will surely hide my face in that day for all the evil which they shall have worked, in that they are turned to other gods.
- 19 "Now therefore write this song for yourselves, and teach it to the children of Israel: put it in their mouths, that this song may be a witness for me against the children of Israel.
- 20 For when I shall have brought them into the land which I swore to their fathers, flowing with milk and honey, and they shall have eaten and filled themselves, and grown fat; then will they turn to other gods, and serve them, and despise me, and break my covenant.
- 21 It shall happen, when many evils and troubles have come on them, that this song shall testify before them as a witness; for it shall not be forgotten out of the mouths of their seed: for I know their imagination which they frame this day, before I have brought them into the land which I swore."
- 22 So Moses wrote this song the same day, and taught it the children of Israel.
- 23 He commissioned Joshua the son of Nun, and said, "Be strong and courageous; for you shall bring the children of Israel into the land which I swore to them: and I will be with you."
- 24 It happened, when Moses had made an end of writing the words of this Torah (teaching and instruction) in a book, until they were finished,
- 25 that Moses commanded the Levites, who bore the ark of the covenant of YAHWEH, saying,
- 26 "Take this scroll of the Torah, and put it by the side of the ark of the covenant of YAHWEH your ELOHIM, that it may be there for a witness against you.
- 27 For I know your rebellion, and your stiff neck: behold, while I am yet alive with you this day, you have been rebellious against YAHWEH; and how much more after my death?
- 28 Assemble to me all the elders of your tribes, and your officers, that I may speak these words in their ears, and call heaven and earth to witness against them.
- 29 For I know that after my death you will utterly corrupt yourselves, and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you; and evil will happen to you in the latter days; because you will do that which is evil in the sight of YAHWEH, to provoke him to anger through the work of your hands."

30 . The Song of Moses. .

Moses spoke in the ears of all the assembly of Israel the words of this song, until they were finished.

Revelation 5.

1 . The Lamb Takes the Scroll. .

I saw, in the right hand of him who sat on the throne, a book written inside and outside, sealed shut with seven seals.

- 2 I saw a mighty angel proclaiming with a loud voice, "Who is worthy to open the book, and to break its seals?"
- 3 No one in heaven above, or on the earth, or under the earth, was able to open the book,

or to look in it.

- 4 And I wept much, because no one was found worthy to open the book, or to look in it.
- 5 One of the elders said to me, "Don't weep. Behold, the Lion who is of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has overcome; he who opens the book and its seven seals."
- 6 I saw in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, a Lamb standing, as though it had been slain, having seven horns, and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of ELOHIM, sent out into all the earth.
- 7 Then he came, and he took it out of the right hand of him who sat on the throne.

8 . Worthy Is the Lamb. .

Now when he had taken the book, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each one having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the holy ones.

- 9 They sang a new song, saying, "You are worthy to take the book, and to open its seals: for you were killed, and bought us for ELOHIM with your blood, out of every tribe, language, people, and nation,
- 10 and made us kings and priests to our ELOHIM, and we will reign on earth."
- 11 I saw, and I heard something like a voice of many angels around the throne, the living creatures, and the elders; and the number of them was ten thousands of ten thousands, and thousands of thousands;
- 12 saying with a loud voice, "Worthy is the Lamb who has been killed to receive the power, wealth, wisdom, strength, honor, glory, and blessing!"
- 13 I heard every created thing which is in heaven, on the earth, under the earth, on the sea, and everything in them, saying, "To him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb be the blessing, the honor, the glory, and the dominion, forever and ever! Amen!"
- 14 The four living creatures said, "Amen!" The elders fell down and worshiped.

Tuesday - Day 3 before Shabbat - Parasha Nitzavim-Vayeilech - You Are Standing - And He Went.

Haftarah:

Isaiah 55:6-to-end.

- 6 Seek YAHWEH while he may be found; call you on him while he is near:
- 7 let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; and let him return to YAHWEH, and he will have mercy on him; and to our ELOHIM, for he will abundantly pardon.
- 8 "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways," says YAHWEH!
- 9 "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.
- 10 For as the rain comes down and the snow from the sky, and doesn't return there, but waters the earth, and makes it bring forth and bud, and gives seed to the sower and bread to the eater;
- 11 so shall my word be that goes forth out of my mouth: it shall not return to me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing I sent it to do.
- 12 For you shall go out with joy, and be led forth with peace: the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing; and all the trees of the fields shall clap their hands.
- 13 Instead of the thorn shall come up the fir tree; and instead of the brier shall come up the myrtle tree: and it shall be to YAHWEH for a name, for an everlasting sign that shall not be cut off."

Revelation 6.,7.

<u>. First Seal: The Conqueror. .</u>

I saw that the Lamb opened one of the seven seals, and I heard one of the four living creatures saying, as with a voice of thunder, "Come and see!"

2 And behold, a white horse, and he who sat on it had a bow. A crown was given to him, and he came forth conquering, and to conquer.

3 . Second Seal: Conflict on Earth. .

When he opened the second seal, I heard the second living creature saying, "Come!" 4 Another came forth, a red horse. To him who sat on it was given power to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another. There was given to him a great sword.

5 . Third Seal: Scarcity on Earth. .

When he opened the third seal, I heard the third living creature saying, "Come and see!" And behold, a black horse, and he who sat on it had a balance in his hand.

6 I heard a voice in the midst of the four living creatures saying, "A choenix of wheat for a denarius, and three choenix of barley for a denarius! Don't damage the oil and the wine!"

7 . Fourth Seal: Widespread Death on Earth. .

When he opened the fourth seal, I heard the fourth living creature saying, "Come and see!"

8 And behold, a pale horse, and he who sat on it, his name was Death. Sheol followed with him. Authority over one fourth of the earth, to kill with the sword, with famine, with death, and by the wild animals of the earth was given to him.

9 . Fifth Seal: The Cry of the Martyrs. .

When he opened the fifth seal, I saw underneath the altar the souls of those who had been killed for the Word of ELOHIM, and for the testimony of the Lamb which they had. 10 They cried with a loud voice, saying, "How long, Master, the holy and true, until you

- judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?"
- 11 A long white robe was given to each of them. They were told that they should rest yet for a while, until their fellow servants and their brothers, who would also be killed even as they were, should complete their course.

. Sixth Seal: Cosmic Disturbances. .

I saw when he opened the sixth seal, and there was a great earthquake. The sun became black as sackcloth made of hair, and the whole moon became as blood.

- 13 The stars of the sky fell to the earth, like a fig tree dropping its unripe figs when it is shaken by a great wind.
- 14 The sky was removed like a scroll when it is rolled up. Every mountain and island were moved out of their places.
- 15 The kings of the earth, the princes, the commanding officers, the rich, the strong, and every slave and free person, hid themselves in the caves and in the rocks of the mountains.
- 16 They told the mountains and the rocks, "Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him who sits on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb,
- 17 for the great day of his wrath has come; and who is able to stand?"

1 . The Sealed of Israel. .

After this, I saw four angels standing at the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, so that no wind would blow on the earth, or on the sea, or on any tree.

- 2 I saw another angel ascend from the sunrise, having the seal of the living ELOHIM! He cried with a loud voice to the four angels to whom it was given to harm the earth and the sea,
- 3 saying, "Don't harm the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, until we have sealed the bondservants of our ELOHIM on their foreheads!"
- 4 I heard the number of those who were sealed, one hundred forty-four thousand, sealed out of every tribe of the children of Israel:
- 5 of the tribe of Judah were sealed twelve thousand, of the tribe of Reuben twelve thousand, of the tribe of Gad twelve thousand,
- 6 of the tribe of Asher twelve thousand, of the tribe of Naphtali twelve thousand, of the tribe of Manasseh twelve thousand,
- 7 of the tribe of Simeon twelve thousand, of the tribe of Levi twelve thousand, of the tribe of Issachar twelve thousand,
- 8 of the tribe of Zebulun twelve thousand, of the tribe of Joseph twelve thousand, of the tribe of Benjamin were sealed twelve thousand.

9 . A Multitude from the Great Tribulation. .

After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude, which no man could number, out of every nation and of all tribes, peoples, and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, dressed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands.

10 They cried with a loud voice, saying, "Salvation be to our ELOHIM, who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!"

- 11 All the angels were standing around the throne, the elders, and the four living creatures; and they fell on their faces before his throne, and worshiped ELOHIM, 12 saying, "Amen! Blessing, glory, wisdom, thanksgiving, honor, power, and might, be to our ELOHIM forever and ever! Amen."
- 13 One of the elders answered, saying to me, "These who are arrayed in white robes, who are they, and from where did they come?"
- 14 I told him, "My master, you know." He said to me, "These are those who came out of the great tribulation. They washed their robes, and made them white in the Lamb's blood.
- 15 Therefore they are before the throne of ELOHIM, they serve him day and night in his temple. He who sits on the throne will spread his tabernacle over them.
- 16 They will never be hungry, neither thirsty any more; neither will the sun beat on them, nor any heat;
- 17 for the Lamb who is in the midst of the throne shepherds them, and leads them to springs of waters of life. And ELOHIM will wipe away every tear from their eyes."

Haftarah (continued):

Isaiah 56:1-8.

. Salvation for the Gentiles. .

Thus says YAHWEH, "Keep justice, and do righteousness; for my salvation [yeshuah-ti] is near to come, and my righteousness to be revealed.

- 2 Blessed is the man who does this, and the son of man who holds it fast; who keeps the Sabbath from profaning it, and keeps his hand from doing any evil."
- 3 Neither let the foreigner, who has joined himself to YAHWEH, speak, saying,
- "YAHWEH will surely separate me from his people;" neither let the eunuch say, "Behold, I am a dry tree."
- 4 For thus says YAHWEH, "To the eunuchs who keep my Sabbaths, and choose the things that please me, and hold fast my covenant:
- 5 to them I will give in my house and within my walls a memorial and a name better than of sons and of daughters; I will give them an everlasting name, that shall not be cut off.
- 6 Also the foreigners who join themselves to YAHWEH, to minister to him, and to love the name of YAHWEH, to be his servants, everyone who keeps the Sabbath from profaning it, and holds fast my covenant;
- 7 even them will I bring to my holy mountain, and make them joyful in my house of prayer: their burnt offerings and their sacrifices shall be accepted on my altar; for my house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples."
- 8 ADONAI YAHWEH, who gathers the outcasts of Israel, says, "Yet will I gather others to him, besides his own who are gathered."

Revelation 8.,9.

. Seventh Seal: Prelude to the Seven Trumpets. .

When he opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour. 2 I saw the seven angels who stand before ELOHIM, and seven shofars were given to them

- 3 Another angel came and stood over the altar, having a golden censer. Much incense was given to him, that he should add it to the prayers of all the holy ones on the golden altar which was before the throne.
- 4 The smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the holy ones, went up before ELOHIM out of the angel's hand.
- 5 The angel took the censer, and he filled it with the fire of the altar, and threw it on the earth. There followed thunders, sounds, lightnings, and an earthquake.
- 6 The seven angels who had the seven shofars prepared themselves to sound.

7 . First Trumpet: Vegetation Struck. .

The first sounded, and there followed hail and fire, mixed with blood, and they were thrown to the earth. One third of the earth was burnt up, and one third of the trees were burnt up, and all green grass was burnt up.

8 . Second Trumpet: The Seas Struck. .

The second angel sounded, and something like a great burning mountain was thrown into the sea. One third of the sea became blood,

9 and one third of the living creatures which were in the sea died. One third of the ships were destroyed.

10 . Third Trumpet: The Waters Struck. .

The third angel sounded, and a great star fell from the sky, burning like a torch, and it fell on one third of the rivers, and on the springs of the waters.

11 The name of the star is called "Wormwood." One third of the waters became wormwood. Many people died from the waters, because they were made bitter.

. Fourth Trumpet: The Heavens Struck. .

The fourth angel sounded, and one third of the sun was struck, and one third of the moon, and one third of the stars; so that one third of them would be darkened, and the day wouldn't shine for one third of it, and the night in the same way.

13 I saw, and I heard an eagle, flying in mid heaven, saying with a loud voice, "Woe! Woe! Woe for those who dwell on the earth, because of the other voices of the shofars of the three angels, who are yet to sound!"

1 . Fifth Trumpet: The Locusts from the Bottomless Pit. .

The fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star from the sky which had fallen to the earth. The key to the pit of the abyss was given to him.

- 2 He opened the pit of the abyss, and smoke went up out of the pit, like the smoke from a burning furnace. The sun and the air were darkened because of the smoke from the pit.
- 3 Then out of the smoke came forth locusts on the earth, and power was given to them, as the scorpions of the earth have power.
- 4 They were told that they should not hurt the grass of the earth, neither any green thing, neither any tree, but only those people who don't have ELOHIM's seal on their foreheads.
- 5 They were given power not to kill them, but to torment them for five months. Their torment was like the torment of a scorpion, when it strikes a person.
- 6 In those days people will seek death, and will in no way find it. They will desire to die, and death will flee from them.
- 7 The shapes of the locusts were like horses prepared for war. On their heads were something like golden crowns, and their faces were like people's faces.
- 8 They had hair like women's hair, and their teeth were like those of lions.
- 9 They had breastplates, like breastplates of iron. The sound of their wings was like the sound of chariots, or of many horses rushing to war.
- 10 They have tails like those of scorpions, and stings. In their tails they have power to harm men for five months.
- 11 They have over them as king the angel of the abyss. His name in Hebrew is "Abaddon," but in Greek, he has the name "Apollyon."
- 12 The first woe is past. Behold, there are still two woes coming after this.

13 . Sixth Trumpet: The Angels from the Euphrates. .

The sixth angel sounded. I heard a voice from the horns of the golden altar which is before ELOHIM,

- 14 saying to the sixth angel who had one shofar, "Free the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates!"
- 15 The four angels were freed who had been prepared for that hour and day and month and year, so that they might kill one third of mankind.
- 16 The number of the armies of the horsemen was two hundred million. I heard the number of them.
- 17 Thus I saw the horses in the vision, and those who sat on them, having breastplates of fiery red, hyacinth blue, and sulfur yellow; and the heads of lions. Out of their mouths proceed fire, smoke, and sulfur.
- 18 By these three plagues were one third of mankind killed: by the fire, the smoke, and the sulfur, which proceeded out of their mouths.
- 19 For the power of the horses is in their mouths, and in their tails. For their tails are like serpents, and have heads, and with them they harm.
- 20 The rest of mankind, who were not killed with these plagues, didn't repent of the works of their hands, that they wouldn't worship demons, and the idols of gold, and of silver, and of brass, and of stone, and of wood; which can neither see, nor hear, nor walk.
- 21 They didn't repent of their murders, nor of their sorceries, nor of their sexual immorality, nor of their thefts.

Isaiah 61:10-to-end.

- 10 I will greatly rejoice in YAHWEH, my soul shall be joyful in my ELOHIM; for he has clothed me with the garments of salvation, he has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself with a garland, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.
- 11 For as the earth brings forth its bud, and as the garden causes the things that are sown in it to spring forth; so ADONAI YAHWEH will cause righteousness and praise to spring forth before all the nations.

Revelation 10.,11.

. The Mighty Angel with the Little Book. .

I saw a mighty angel coming down out of the sky, clothed with a cloud. A rainbow was on his head. His face was like the sun, and his feet like pillars of fire.

- 2 He had in his hand a little open book. He set his right foot on the sea, and his left on the land.
- 3 He cried with a loud voice, as a lion roars. When he cried, the seven thunders uttered their voices.
- 4 When the seven thunders sounded, I was about to write; but I heard a voice from the sky saying, "Seal up the things which the seven thunders said, and don't write them."
- 5 The angel whom I saw standing on the sea and on the land lifted up his right hand to the sky,
- 6 and swore by him who lives forever and ever, who created heaven and the things that are in it, the earth and the things that are in it, and the sea and the things that are in it, that there will no longer be delay,
- 7 but in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he is about to sound, then the mystery of ELOHIM is finished, as he declared to his servants, the prophets.

8 . John Eats the Little Book. .

The voice which I heard from heaven, again speaking with me, said, "Go, take the book which is open in the hand of the angel who stands on the sea and on the land."

- 9 I went to the angel, telling him to give me the little book. He said to me, "Take it, and eat it up. It will make your stomach bitter, but in your mouth it will be as sweet as honey."
- 10 I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up. It was as sweet as honey in my mouth. When I had eaten it, my stomach was made bitter.
- 11 They told me, "You must prophesy again over many peoples, nations, languages, and kings."

1 . The Two Witnesses. .

A reed like a rod was given to me. Someone said, "Rise, and measure ELOHIM's temple, and the altar, and those who worship in it.

2 Leave out the court which is outside of the temple, and don't measure it, for it has been

given to the nations. They will tread the holy city under foot for forty-two months.

- 3 I will give power to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy one thousand two hundred sixty days, clothed in sackcloth."
- 4 These are the two olive trees and the two menorahs, standing before ADONAI of the earth.
- 5 If anyone desires to harm them, fire proceeds out of their mouth and devours their enemies. If anyone desires to harm them, he must be killed in this way.
- 6 These have the power to shut up the sky, that it may not rain during the days of their prophecy. They have power over the waters, to turn them into blood, and to strike the earth with every plague, as often as they desire.

7 . The Witnesses Killed. .

When they have finished their testimony, the beast that comes up out of the abyss will make war with them, and overcome them, and kill them.

- 8 Their dead bodies will be in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also their ADONAI was crucified.
- 9 From among the peoples, tribes, languages, and nations people will look at their dead bodies for three and a half days, and will not allow their dead bodies to be laid in a tomb.
- 10 Those who dwell on the earth rejoice over them, and they will be glad. They will give gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented those who dwell on the earth.

. The Witnesses Resurrected..

After the three and a half days, the breath of life from ELOHIM entered into them, and they stood on their feet. Great fear fell on those who saw them.

- 12 I heard a loud voice from heaven saying to them, "Come up here!" They went up into heaven in the cloud, and their enemies saw them.
- 13 In that day there was a great earthquake, and a tenth of the city fell. Seven thousand people were killed in the earthquake, and the rest were terrified, and gave glory to the ELOHIM of heaven.
- 14 The second woe is past. Behold, the third woe comes quickly.

15 . Seventh Trumpet: The Kingdom Proclaimed. .

The seventh angel sounded, and great voices in heaven followed, saying, "The kingdom of the world has become the Kingdom of our ADONAI, and of his Messiah. He will reign forever and ever!"

- 16 The twenty-four elders, who sit on their thrones before ELOHIM's throne, fell on their faces and worshiped ELOHIM,
- 17 saying: "We give you thanks, ADONAI ELOHIM, the Almighty, the one who is and who was; because you have taken your great power, and reigned.
- 18 The nations were angry, and your wrath came, as did the time for the dead to be judged, and to give your bondservants the prophets, their reward, as well as to the holy ones, and those who fear your name, to the small and the great; and to destroy those who destroy the earth."
- 19 ELOHIM's temple that is in heaven was opened, and the ark of ADONAI's covenant was seen in his temple. Lightnings, sounds, thunders, an earthquake, and great hail followed.

Isaiah 62.

Assurance of Zion's Salvation.

For Zion's sake will I not hold my peace, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest, until her righteousness go forth as brightness, and her salvation as a lamp that burns.

- 2 The nations shall see your righteousness, and all kings your glory, and you shall be called by a new name, which the mouth of YAHWEH shall name.
- 3 You shall also be a crown of beauty in the hand of YAHWEH, and a royal diadem in the hand of your ELOHIM!
- 4 You shall no more be termed Forsaken; neither shall your land any more be termed Desolate: but you shall be called Hephzibah, and your land Beulah; for YAHWEH delights in you, and your land shall be married.
- 5 For as a young man marries a virgin, so your sons shall marry you; and as the bridegroom rejoices over the bride, so your ELOHIM will rejoice over you.
- 6 I have set watchmen on your walls, Jerusalem; they shall never hold their peace day nor night: you who call on YAHWEH, take no rest,
- 7 and give him no rest, until he establishes, and until he makes Jerusalem a praise in the earth.
- 8 YAHWEH has sworn by his right hand, and by the arm of his strength, "Surely I will no more give your grain to be food for your enemies; and foreigners shall not drink your new wine, for which you have labored:
- 9 but those who have garnered it shall eat it, and praise YAHWEH; and those who have gathered it shall drink it in the courts of my sanctuary."
- 10 Go through, go through the gates! Prepare the way of the people! Cast up, cast up the highway! Gather out the stones! Lift up a banner for the peoples.
- 11 Behold, YAHWEH has proclaimed to the end of the earth, "Say to the daughter of Zion, 'Behold, your salvation comes. Behold, his reward is with him, and his recompense before him."
- 12 They shall call them The holy people, The redeemed of YAHWEH: and you shall be called Sought out, A city not forsaken.

Revelation 12.

1 . The Woman, the Child, and the Dragon. .

A great sign was seen in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars.

- 2 She was with child. She cried out in pain, laboring to give birth.
- 3 Another sign was seen in heaven. Behold, a great red dragon, having seven heads and ten horns, and on his heads seven crowns.
- 4 His tail drew one third of the stars of the sky, and threw them to the earth. The dragon stood before the woman who was about to give birth, so that when she gave birth he might devour her child.
- 5 She gave birth to a son, a male child, who is to rule all the nations with a rod of iron. Her child was caught up to ELOHIM, and to his throne.

6 The woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by ELOHIM, that there they may nourish her one thousand two hundred sixty days.

7 . Satan Thrown Out of Heaven. .

There was war in the sky. Michael and his angels made war on the dragon. The dragon and his angels made war.

- 8 They didn't prevail, neither was a place found for him any more in heaven.
- 9 The great dragon was thrown down, the old serpent, he who is called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world. He was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.
- 10 I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying, "Now the salvation, the power, and the Kingdom of our ELOHIM, and the authority of his Messiah has come; for the accuser of our brothers has been thrown down, who accuses them before our ELOHIM day and night.
- 11 They overcame him because of the Lamb's blood, and because of the word of their testimony. They didn't love their life, even to death.
- 12 Therefore rejoice, heavens, and you who dwell in them. Woe to the earth and to the sea, because the devil has gone down to you, having great wrath, knowing that he has but a short time."

. The Woman Persecuted..

When the dragon saw that he was thrown down to the earth, he persecuted the woman who gave birth to the male child.

- 14 Two wings of the great eagle were given to the woman, that she might fly into the wilderness to her place, so that she might be nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.
- 15 The serpent spewed water out of his mouth after the woman like a river, that he might cause her to be carried away by the stream.
- 16 The earth helped the woman, and the earth opened its mouth and swallowed up the river which the dragon spewed out of his mouth.
- 17 The dragon grew angry with the woman, and went away to make war with the rest of her seed, who keep ELOHIM's commandments and hold YESHUA's testimony.

Isaiah 63:1-9.

1 . YAHWEH in Judgment and Salvation. .

Who is this who comes from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah? this who is glorious in his clothing, marching in the greatness of his strength? "It is I who speak in righteousness, mighty to save."

- 2 Why are you red in your clothing, and your garments like him who treads in the wine vat?
- 3 "I have trodden the winepress alone; and of the peoples there was no man with me: yes, I trod them in my anger, and trampled them in my wrath; and their lifeblood is sprinkled on my garments, and I have stained all my clothing.
- 4 For the day of vengeance was in my heart, and the year of my redeemed has come.
- 5 I looked, and there was none to help; and I wondered that there was none to uphold: therefore my own arm brought salvation to me; and my wrath, it upheld me.
- 6 I trod down the peoples in my anger, and made them drunk in my wrath, and I poured out their lifeblood on the earth."

7 . ELOHIM's Mercy Remembered. .

I will make mention of the loving kindnesses of YAHWEH and the praises of YAHWEH, according to all that YAHWEH has bestowed on us, and the great goodness toward the house of Israel, which he has bestowed on them according to his mercies, and according to the multitude of his loving kindnesses.

- 8 For he said, "Surely, they are my people, children who will not deal falsely:" so he was their Savior.
- 9 In all their affliction he was afflicted, and the angel of his presence saved them: in his love and in his pity he redeemed them; and he bore them, and carried them all the days of old.

Revelation 13.

1 . The Beast from the Sea. .

Then I stood on the sand of the sea. I saw a beast coming up out of the sea, having ten horns and seven heads. On his horns were ten crowns, and on his heads, blasphemous names.

- 2 The beast which I saw was like a leopard, and his feet were like those of a bear, and his mouth like the mouth of a lion. The dragon gave him his power, his throne, and great authority.
- 3 One of his heads looked like it had been wounded fatally. His fatal wound was healed, and the whole earth marveled at the beast.
- 4 They worshiped the dragon, because he gave his authority to the beast, and they worshiped the beast, saying, "Who is like the beast? Who is able to make war with him?"
- 5 A mouth speaking great things and blasphemy was given to him. Authority to make war for forty-two months was given to him.
- 6 He opened his mouth for blasphemy against ELOHIM, to blaspheme his name, and his

dwelling, those who dwell in heaven.

- 7 It was given to him to make war with the holy ones, and to overcome them. Authority over every tribe, people, language, and nation was given to him.
- 8 All who dwell on the earth will worship him, everyone whose name has not been written from the foundation of the world in the book of life of the Lamb who has been killed.
- 9 If anyone has an ear, let him hear.
- 10 If anyone is to go into captivity, he will go into captivity. If anyone is to be killed with the sword, he must be killed. Here is the endurance and the faith of the holy ones.

. The Beast from the Earth..

I saw another beast coming up out of the earth. He had two horns like a lamb, and he spoke like a dragon.

- 12 He exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence. He makes the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose fatal wound was healed.
- 13 He performs great signs, even making fire come down out of the sky to the earth in the sight of people.
- 14 He deceives my own people who dwell on the earth because of the signs he was granted to do in front of the beast; saying to those who dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast who had the sword wound and lived.
- 15 It was given to him to give breath to it, to the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause as many as wouldn't worship the image of the beast to be killed.
- 16 He causes all, the small and the great, the rich and the poor, and the free and the slave, to be given marks on their right hands, or on their foreheads;
- 17 and that no one would be able to buy or to sell, unless he has that mark, the name of the beast or the number of his name.
- 18 Here is wisdom. He who has understanding, let him calculate the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man. His number is six hundred sixty-six.

Revelation 14.

1 . The Lamb and the 144,000...

I saw, and behold, the Lamb standing on Mount Zion, and with him a number, one hundred forty-four thousand, having his name, and the name of his Father, written on their foreheads.

- 2 I heard a sound from heaven, like the sound of many waters, and like the sound of a great thunder. The sound which I heard was like that of harpists playing on their harps.
- 3 They sing a new song before the throne, and before the four living creatures and the elders. No one could learn the song except the one hundred forty-four thousand, those who had been redeemed out of the earth.
- 4 These are those who were not defiled with women, for they are virgins. These are those who follow the Lamb wherever he goes. These were redeemed by YESHUA from among men, the first fruits to ELOHIM and to the Lamb.
- 5 In their mouth was found no lie, for they are blameless.

6 . The Proclamations of Three Angels. .

I saw an angel flying in mid heaven, having an eternal Good News to proclaim to those who dwell on the earth, and to every nation, tribe, language, and people.

- 7 He said with a loud voice, "Fear ADONAI, and give him glory; for the hour of his judgment has come. Worship him who made the heaven, the earth, the sea, and the springs of waters!"
- 8 Another, a second angel, followed, saying, "Babylon the great has fallen, which has made all the nations to drink of the wine of the wrath of her sexual immorality."
- 9 Another angel, a third, followed them, saying with a great voice, "If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives a mark on his forehead, or on his hand,
- 10 he also will drink of the wine of the wrath of ELOHIM, which is prepared unmixed in the cup of his anger. He will be tormented with fire and sulfur in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb.
- 11 The smoke of their torment goes up forever and ever. They have no rest day and night, those who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name.
- 12 Here is the patience of the holy ones, those who keep the commandments of ELOHIM, and the faith of YESHUA!"
- 13 I heard the voice from heaven saying, "Write, 'Blessed are the dead who die in ADONAI from now on." "Yes," says the Spirit, "that they may rest from their labors; for their works follow with them."

. Reaping the Earth's Harvest..

I looked, and behold, a white cloud; and on the cloud one sitting like a son of man, having on his head a golden crown, and in his hand a sharp sickle.

- 15 Another angel came out from the temple, crying with a loud voice to him who sat on the cloud, "Send forth your sickle, and reap; for the hour to reap has come; for the harvest of the earth is ripe!"
- 16 He who sat on the cloud thrust his sickle on the earth, and the earth was reaped.

. Reaping the Grapes of Wrath..

Another angel came out from the temple which is in heaven. He also had a sharp sickle. 18 Another angel came out from the altar, he who has power over fire, and he called with a great voice to him who had the sharp sickle, saying, "Send forth your sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth, for the earth's grapes are fully ripe!"

- 19 The angel thrust his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vintage of the earth, and threw it into the great winepress of the wrath of ELOHIM!
- 20 The winepress was trodden outside of the city, and blood came out from the winepress, even to the bridles of the horses, as far as one thousand six hundred stadia.
