### Psalms 22.

# 1 . To the Chief Musician. Set to The Deer of the Dawn. A Psalm of David..

For the Chief Musician; set to "The Doe of the Morning." A Psalm by David. My ELOHIM, my ELOHIM, why have you forsaken me? Why are you so far from helping me, and from the words of my groaning?

- 2 My ELOHIM, I cry in the daytime, but you don't answer; in the night season, and am not silent.
- 3 But you are holy, you who inhabit the praises of Israel.
- 4 Our fathers trusted in you. They trusted, and you delivered them.
- 5 They cried to you, and were delivered. They trusted in you, and were not disappointed.
- 6 But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised by the people.
- 7 All those who see me mock me. They insult me with their lips. They shake their heads, saying,
- 8 "He trusts in YHWH; let him deliver him. Let him rescue him, since he delights in him."
- 9 But you brought me out of the womb. You made me trust at my mother's breasts.
- 10 I was thrown on you from my mother's womb. You are my ELOHIM since my mother bore me.
- 11 Don't be far from me, for trouble is near. For there is none to help.
- 12 Many bulls have surrounded me. Strong bulls of Bashan have encircled me.
- 13 They open their mouths wide against me, lions tearing prey and roaring.
- 14 I am poured out like water. All my bones are out of joint. My heart is like wax; it is melted within me.
- 15 My strength is dried up like a potsherd. My tongue sticks to the roof of my mouth. You have brought me into the dust of death.
- 16 For dogs have surrounded me. A company of evildoers have enclosed me. They have pierced my hands and feet.
- 17 I can count all of my bones. They look and stare at me.
- 18 They divide my garments among them. They cast lots for my clothing.
- 19 But don't be far off, YHWH! You are my help: hurry to help me.
- 20 Deliver my soul from the sword, my precious life from the power of the dog.
- 21 Save me from the lion's mouth! Yes, from the horns of the wild oxen, you have answered me.
- 22 I will declare your name to my brothers. In the midst of the assembly, I will praise you.
- 23 You who fear YHWH, praise him! All you descendants of Jacob, glorify him! Stand in awe of him, all you descendants of Israel!
- 24 For he has not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted, Neither has he hidden his face from him; but when he cried to him, he heard.
- 25 Of you comes my praise in the great assembly. I will pay my vows before those who fear him.
- 26 The humble shall eat and be satisfied. They shall praise YHWH who seek after him. Let your hearts live forever.
- 27 All the ends of the earth shall remember and turn to YHWH! All the relatives of the nations shall worship before you.
- 28 For the kingdom is YHWH's. He is the ruler over the nations.
- 29 All the rich ones of the earth shall eat and worship. All those who go down to the dust

shall bow before him, even he who can't keep his soul alive.

- 30 Posterity shall serve him. Future generations shall be told about ADONAI.
- 31 They shall come and shall declare his righteousness to a people that shall be born, for he has done it.

### Proverbs 22.

- 1 A good name is more desirable than great riches, and loving favor is better than silver and gold.
- 2 The rich and the poor have this in common: YHWH is the maker of them all.
- 3 A prudent man sees danger, and hides himself; but the simple pass on, and suffer for it.
- 4 The result of humility and the fear of YHWH is wealth, honor, and life.
- 5 Thorns and snares are in the path of the wicked: whoever guards his soul stays from them.
- 6 Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it.
- 7 The rich rule over the poor. The borrower is servant to the lender.
- 8 He who sows wickedness reaps trouble, and the rod of his fury will be destroyed.
- 9 He who has a generous eye will be blessed; for he shares his food with the poor.
- 10 Drive out the mocker, and strife will go out; yes, quarrels and insults will stop.
- 11 He who loves purity of heart and speaks gracefully is the king's friend.
- 12 The eyes of YHWH watch over knowledge; but he frustrates the words of the unfaithful.
- 13 The sluggard says, "There is a lion outside! I will be killed in the streets!"
- 14 The mouth of an adulteress is a deep pit: he who is under YHWH's wrath will fall into it
- 15 Folly is bound up in the heart of a child: the rod of discipline drives it far from him.
- 16 Whoever oppresses the poor for his own increase and whoever gives to the rich, both come to poverty.

#### 17 . Savings of the Wise. .

Turn your ear, and listen to the words of the wise. Apply your heart to my teaching. 18 For it is a pleasant thing if you keep them within you, if all of them are ready on your lips.

- 19 That your trust may be in YHWH, I teach you today, even you.
- 20 Haven't I written to you thirty excellent things of counsel and knowledge,
- 21 To teach you truth, reliable words, to give sound answers to the ones who sent you?
- 22 Don't exploit the poor, because he is poor; and don't crush the needy in court;
- 23 for YHWH will plead their case, and plunder the life of those who plunder them.
- 24 Don't befriend a hot-tempered man, and don't associate with one who harbors anger:
- 25 lest you learn his ways, and ensnare your soul.
- 26 Don't you be one of those who strike hands, of those who are collateral for debts.
- 27 If you don't have means to pay, why should he take away your bed from under you?
- 28 Don't move the ancient boundary stone, which your fathers have set up.
- 29 Do you see a man skilled in his work? He will serve kings. He won't serve obscure men.
