# Day 97. 6-April Daily Reading (Prophets and Writings).

#### Job 6.

#### 1. Job: My Complaint Is Just. .

Then Job answered.

- 2 "Oh that my anguish were weighed, and all my calamity laid in the balances!
- 3 For now it would be heavier than the sand of the seas, therefore have my words been rash.
- 4 For the arrows of the Almighty are within me. My spirit drinks up their poison. The terrors of ELOHIM set themselves in array against me.
- 5 Does the wild donkey bray when he has grass? Or does the ox low over his fodder?
- 6 Can that which has no flavor be eaten without salt? Or is there any taste in the white of an egg?
- 7 My soul refuses to touch them. They are as loathsome food to me.
- 8 "Oh that I might have my request, that ELOHIM would grant the thing that I long for,
- 9 even that it would please ELOHIM to crush me; that he would let loose his hand, and cut me off!
- 10 Be it still my consolation, yes, let me exult in pain that doesn't spare, that I have not denied the words of the Holy One.
- 11 What is my strength, that I should wait? What is my end, that I should be patient?
- 12 Is my strength the strength of stones? Or is my flesh of brass?
- 13 Isn't it that I have no help in me, That wisdom is driven quite from me?
- 14 "To him who is ready to faint, kindness should be shown from his friend; even to him who forsakes the fear of the Almighty.
- 15 My brothers have dealt deceitfully as a brook, as the channel of brooks that pass away:
- 16 Which are black by reason of the ice, in which the snow hides itself.
- 17 In the dry season, they vanish. When it is hot, they are consumed out of their place.
- 18 The caravans that travel beside them turn aside. They go up into the waste, and perish.
- 19 The caravans of Tema looked. The companies of Sheba waited for them.
- 20 They were distressed because they were confident. They came there, and were confounded.
- 21 For now you are nothing. You see a terror, and are afraid.
- 22 Did I say, 'Give to me?' or, 'Offer a present for me from your substance?'
- 23 or, 'Deliver me from the adversary's hand?' or, 'Redeem me from the hand of the oppressors?'
- 24 "Teach me, and I will hold my peace. Cause me to understand wherein I have erred.
- 25 How forcible are words of uprightness! But your reproof, what does it reprove?
- 26 Do you intend to reprove words, since the speeches of one who is desperate are as wind?
- 27 Yes, you would even cast lots for the fatherless, and make merchandise of your friend.
- 28 Now therefore be pleased to look at me, for surely I shall not lie to your face.
- 29 Please return. Let there be no injustice. Yes, return again. My cause is righteous.
- 30 Is there injustice on my tongue? Can't my taste discern mischievous things?

#### Psalms 96.

### 1. A Song of Praise to ELOHIM Coming in Judgment. .

### 6 April Daily Reading (Prophets and Writings).

Job 6, Psalms 96, Proverbs 24.

Sing to YHWH a new song! Sing to YHWH, all the earth.

- 2 Sing to YHWH! Bless his name! Proclaim his salvation from day to day!
- 3 Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples.
- 4 For great is YHWH, and greatly to be praised! He is to be feared above all gods.
- 5 For all the gods of the peoples are idols, but YHWH made the heavens.
- 6 Honor and majesty are before him. Strength and beauty are in his sanctuary.
- 7 Ascribe to YHWH, you families of nations, ascribe to YHWH glory and strength.
- 8 Ascribe to YHWH the glory due to his name. Bring an offering, and come into his courts.
- 9 Worship YHWH in holy array. Tremble before him, all the earth.
- 10 Say among the nations, "YHWH reigns." The world is also established. It can't be moved. He will judge the peoples with equity.
- 11 Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth rejoice. Let the sea roar, and its fullness!
- 12 Let the field and all that is in it exult! Then all the trees of the woods shall sing for joy
- 13 before YHWH; for he comes, for he comes to judge the earth. He will judge the world with righteousness, the peoples with his truth.

### Proverbs 24.

- 1 Don't be envious of evil men; neither desire to be with them:
- 2 for their hearts plot violence, and their lips talk about mischief.
- 3 Through wisdom a house is built; by understanding it is established;
- 4 by knowledge the rooms are filled with all rare and beautiful treasure.
- 5 A wise man has great power; and a knowledgeable man increases strength;
- 6 for by wise guidance you wage your war; and victory is in many advisors.
- 7 Wisdom is too high for a fool: he doesn't open his mouth in the gate.
- 8 One who plots to do evil will be called a schemer.
- 9 The schemes of folly are sin. The mocker is detested by men.
- 10 If you falter in the time of trouble, your strength is small.
- 11 Rescue those who are being led away to death! Indeed, hold back those who are staggering to the slaughter!
- 12 If you say, "Behold, we didn't know this;" doesn't he who weighs the hearts consider it? He who keeps your soul, doesn't he know it? Shall he not render to every man according to his work?
- 13 My son, eat honey, for it is good; the droppings of the honeycomb, which are sweet to your taste:
- 14 so you shall know wisdom to be to your soul; if you have found it, then there will be a reward, your hope will not be cut off.
- 15 Don't lay in wait, wicked man, against the habitation of the righteous. Don't destroy his resting place:
- 16 for a righteous man falls seven times, and rises up again; but the wicked are overthrown by calamity.
- 17 Don't rejoice when your enemy falls. Don't let your heart be glad when he is overthrown;
- 18 lest YHWH see it, and it displease him, and he turn away his wrath from him.
- 19 Don't fret yourself because of evildoers; neither be envious of the wicked:
- 20 for there will be no reward to the evil man; and the lamp of the wicked shall be snuffed out.
- 21 My son, fear YHWH and the king. Don't join those who are rebellious:
- 22 for their calamity will rise suddenly; the destruction from them both who knows?

Job 6, Psalms 96, Proverbs 24.

#### 23 . Further Sayings of the Wise. .

These also are sayings of the wise. To show partiality in judgment is not good.

- 24 He who says to the wicked, "You are righteous;" peoples shall curse him, and nations shall abhor him
- 25 but it will go well with those who convict the guilty, and a rich blessing will come on them.
- 26 An honest answer is like a kiss on the lips.
- 27 Prepare your work outside, and get your fields ready. Afterwards, build your house.
- 28 Don't be a witness against your neighbor without cause. Don't deceive with your lips.
- 29 Don't say, "I will do to him as he has done to me; I will render to the man according to his work."
- 30 I went by the field of the sluggard, by the vineyard of the man void of understanding;
- 31 Behold, it was all grown over with thorns. Its surface was covered with nettles, and its stone wall was broken down.
- 32 Then I saw, and considered well. I saw, and received instruction:
- 33 a little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to sleep;
- 34 so your poverty will come as a robber, and your want as an armed man.
