Day 108. 17-April Daily Reading (Prophets and Writings).

Job 17.

1. Job Prays for Relief..

- "My spirit is consumed. My days are extinct, And the grave is ready for me.
- 2 Surely there are mockers with me. My eye dwells on their provocation.
- 3 "Now give a pledge, be collateral for me with yourself. Who is there who will strike hands with me?
- 4 For you have hidden their heart from understanding, Therefore you shall not exalt them.
- 5 He who denounces his friends for a prey, Even the eyes of his children shall fail.
- 6 "But he has made me a byword of the people. They spit in my face.
- 7 My eye also is dim by reason of sorrow. All my members are as a shadow.
- 8 Upright men shall be astonished at this. The innocent shall stir up himself against the godless.
- 9 Yet shall the righteous hold on his way. He who has clean hands shall grow stronger and stronger.
- 10 But as for you all, come on now again; I shall not find a wise man among you.
- 11 My days are past, my plans are broken off, as are the thoughts of my heart.
- 12 They change the night into day, saying 'The light is near' in the presence of darkness.
- 13 If I look for Sheol as my house, if I have spread my couch in the darkness,
- 14 If I have said to corruption, 'You are my father;' to the worm, 'My mother,' and 'my sister;'
- 15 where then is my hope? as for my hope, who shall see it?
- 16 Shall it go down with me to the gates of Sheol, or descend together into the dust?"

Psalms 107.

1. Thanksgiving to YHWH for His Great Works of Deliverance. .

Give thanks to YHWH, for he is good, for his loving kindness endures forever.

- 2 Let the redeemed by YHWH say so, whom he has redeemed from the hand of the adversary,
- 3 And gathered out of the lands, from the east and from the west, from the north and from the south.
- 4 They wandered in the wilderness in a desert way. They found no city to live in.
- 5 Hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted in them.
- 6 Then they cried to YHWH in their trouble, and he delivered them out of their distresses,
- 7 he led them also by a straight way, that they might go to a city to live in.
- 8 Let them praise YHWH for his loving kindness, for his wonderful works to the children of men!
- 9 For he satisfies the longing soul. He fills the hungry soul with good.
- 10 Some sat in darkness and in the shadow of death, being bound in affliction and iron,
- 11 because they rebelled against the words of EL, and condemned the counsel of the Most High.
- 12 Therefore he brought down their heart with labor. They fell down, and there was none to help.
- 13 Then they cried to YHWH in their trouble, and he saved them out of their distresses.
- 14 He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death, and broke their bonds in sunder.

- 15 Let them praise YHWH for his loving kindness, for his wonderful works to the children of men!
- 16 For he has broken the gates of brass, and cut through bars of iron.
- 17 Fools are afflicted because of their disobedience, and because of their iniquities.
- 18 Their soul abhors all kinds of food. They draw near to the gates of death.
- 19 Then they cry to YHWH in their trouble, he saves them out of their distresses.
- 20 He sends his word, and heals them, and delivers them from their graves.
- 21 Let them praise YHWH for his loving kindness, for his wonderful works to the children of men!
- 22 Let them offer the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare his works with singing.
- 23 Those who go down to the sea in ships, who do business in great waters;
- 24 These see YHWH's works, and his wonders in the deep.
- 25 For he commands, and raises the stormy wind, which lifts up its waves.
- 26 They mount up to the sky; they go down again to the depths. Their soul melts away because of trouble.
- 27 They reel back and forth, and stagger like a drunken man, and are at their wits' end.
- 28 Then they cry to YHWH in their trouble, and he brings them out of their distress.
- 29 He makes the storm a calm, so that its waves are still.
- 30 Then they are glad because it is calm, so he brings them to their desired haven.
- 31 Let them praise YHWH for his loving kindness, for his wonderful works for the children of men!
- 32 Let them exalt him also in the assembly of the people, and praise him in the seat of the elders.
- 33 He turns rivers into a desert, water springs into a thirsty ground,
- 34 and a fruitful land into a salt waste, for the wickedness of those who dwell in it.
- 35 He turns a desert into a pool of water, and a dry land into water springs.
- 36 There he makes the hungry live, that they may prepare a city to live in.
- 37 sow fields, plant vineyards, and reap the fruits of increase.
- 38 He blesses them also, so that they are multiplied greatly. He doesn't allow their livestock to decrease.
- 39 Again, they are diminished and bowed down through oppression, trouble, and sorrow.
- 40 He pours contempt on princes, and causes them to wander in a trackless waste.
- 41 Yet he lifts the needy out of their affliction, and increases their families like a flock.
- 42 The upright will see it, and be glad. All the wicked will shut their mouths.
- 43 Whoever is wise will pay attention to these things. They will consider the loving kindnesses of YHWH!

Proverbs 4.

1 . Security in Wisdom. .

Listen, sons, to a father's instruction. Pay attention and know understanding;

- 2 for I give you sound learning. Don't forsake my Torah (teaching and instruction).
- 3 For I was a son to my father, tender and an only child in the sight of my mother.
- 4 He taught me, and said to me: "Let your heart retain my words. Keep my commandments, and live.
- 5 Get wisdom. Get understanding. Don't forget, neither swerve from the words of my mouth.
- 6 Don't forsake her, and she will preserve you. Love her, and she will keep you.
- 7 Wisdom is supreme. Get wisdom. Yes, though it costs all your possessions, get understanding.

Job 17, Psalms 107, Proverbs 4.

- 8 Esteem her, and she will exalt you. She will bring you to honor, when you embrace her.
- 9 She will give to your head a garland of grace. She will deliver a crown of splendor to you."
- 10 Listen, my son, and receive my sayings. The years of your life will be many.
- 11 I have taught you in the way of wisdom. I have led you in straight paths.
- 12 When you go, your steps will not be hampered. When you run, you will not stumble.
- 13 Take firm hold of instruction. Don't let her go. Keep her, for she is your life.
- 14 Don't enter into the path of the wicked. Don't walk in the way of evil men.
- 15 Avoid it, and don't pass by it. Turn from it, and pass on.
- 16 For they don't sleep, unless they do evil. Their sleep is taken away, unless they make someone fall.
- 17 For they eat the bread of wickedness, and drink the wine of violence.
- 18 But the path of the righteous is like the dawning light, that shines more and more until the perfect day.
- 19 The way of the wicked is like darkness. They don't know what they stumble over.
- 20 My son, attend to my words. Turn your ear to my sayings.
- 21 Let them not depart from your eyes. Keep them in the midst of your heart.
- 22 For they are life to those who find them, and health to their whole body.
- 23 Keep your heart with all diligence, for out of it is the wellspring of life.
- 24 Put away from yourself a perverse mouth. Put corrupt lips far from you.
- 25 Let your eyes look straight ahead. Fix your gaze directly before you.
- 26 Make the path of your feet level. Let all of your ways be established.
- 27 Don't turn to the right hand nor to the left. Remove your foot from evil.
