# Day 301. 27-October Daily Reading (Prophets and Writings).

### Isaiah 25.

#### 1 . Praise to ELOHIM. .

YHWH, you are my ELOHIM! I will exalt you! I will praise your name, for you have done wonderful things, things planned long ago, in complete faithfulness and truth.

- 2 For you have made a city into a heap, a fortified city into a ruin, a palace of strangers to be no city. It will never be built.
- 3 Therefore a strong people will glorify you. A city of awesome nations will fear you.
- 4 For you have been a stronghold to the poor, a stronghold to the needy in his distress, a refuge from the storm, a shade from the heat, when the blast of the dreaded ones is like a storm against the wall.
- 5 As the heat in a dry place will you bring down the noise of strangers; as the heat by the shade of a cloud, the song of the dreaded ones will be brought low.
- 6 In this mountain, YHWH of Hosts will make all peoples a feast of fat things, a feast of choice wines, of fat things full of marrow, of well refined choice wines.
- 7 He will destroy in this mountain the surface of the covering that covers all peoples, and the veil that is spread over all nations.
- 8 He has swallowed up death forever! ADONAI YHWH will wipe away tears from off all faces. He will take the reproach of his people away from off all the earth, for YHWH has spoken it.
- 9 It shall be said in that day, "Behold, this is our ELOHIM! We have waited for him, and he will save us! This is YHWH! We have waited for him. We will be glad and rejoice in his salvation!"
- 10 For in this mountain the hand of YHWH will rest. Moab will be trodden down in his place, even like straw is trodden down in the water of the dunghill.
- 11 He will spread out his hands in its midst, like one who swims spreads out hands to swim, but his pride will be humbled together with the craft of his hands.
- 12 He has brought the high fortress of your walls down, laid low, and brought to the ground, even to the dust.

## Isaiah 26.

### 1 . A Song of Salvation. .

In that day, this song will be sung in the land of Judah: "We have a strong city. ELOHIM appoints salvation for walls and bulwarks.

- 2 Open the gates, that the righteous nation may enter: the one which keeps faith.
- 3 You will keep whoever's mind is steadfast in perfect peace, because he trusts in you.
- 4 Trust in YHWH forever; for in YAH, YHWH, is an everlasting Rock.
- 5 For he has brought down those who dwell on high, the lofty city. He lays it low. He lays it low even to the ground. He brings it even to the dust.
- 6 The foot shall tread it down; Even the feet of the poor, and the steps of the needy."
- 7 The way of the just is uprightness. You who are upright make the path of the righteous level.
- 8 Yes, in the way of your judgments, YHWH, have we waited for you. Your name and your renown are the desire of our soul.
- 9 With my soul have I desired you in the night. Yes, with my spirit within me will I seek you earnestly; for when your judgments are in the earth, the inhabitants of the world learn righteousness.
- 10 Let favor be shown to the wicked, yet he will not learn righteousness. In the land of

uprightness he will deal wrongfully, and will not see YHWH's majesty.

- 11 YHWH, your hand is lifted up, yet they don't see; but they will see your zeal for the people, and be disappointed. Yes, fire will consume your adversaries.
- 12 YHWH, you will ordain peace for us, for you have also worked all our works for us.
- 13 YHWH our ELOHIM, other masters besides you have had dominion over us, but by you only will we make mention of your name.
- 14 The dead shall not live. The deceased shall not rise. Therefore have you visited and destroyed them, and caused all memory of them to perish.
- 15 You have increased the nation, O YHWH! You have increased the nation! You are glorified! You have enlarged all the borders of the land.
- 16 YHWH, in trouble they have visited you. They poured out a prayer when your chastening was on them.
- 17 Like as a woman with child, who draws near the time of her delivery, is in pain and cries out in her pangs; so we have been before you, YHWH!
- 18 We have been with child. We have been in pain. We gave birth, it seems, only to wind. We have not worked any deliverance in the earth; neither have the inhabitants of the world fallen.
- 19 Your dead shall live. My dead bodies shall arise. Awake and sing, you who dwell in the dust; for your dew is like the dew of herbs, and the earth will cast forth the dead.

## 20 . Take Refuge from the Coming Judgment. .

Come, my people, enter into your rooms, and shut your doors behind you. Hide yourself for a little moment, until the indignation is past.

21 For, behold, YHWH comes forth out of his place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity. The earth also will disclose her blood, and will no longer cover her slain.

#### Psalms 117.

## 1 . Let All Peoples Praise YHWH...

Praise YHWH, all you nations! Extol him, all you peoples!

2 For his loving kindness is great toward us. YHWH's faithfulness endures forever. Praise YAH!

#### Proverbs 11.

- 1 A false balance is an abomination to YHWH, but accurate weights are his delight.
- 2 When pride comes, then comes shame, but with humility comes wisdom.
- 3 The integrity of the upright shall guide them, but the perverseness of the treacherous shall destroy them.
- 4 Riches don't profit in the day of wrath, but righteousness delivers from death.
- 5 The righteousness of the blameless will direct his way, but the wicked shall fall by his own wickedness.
- 6 The righteousness of the upright shall deliver them, but the unfaithful will be trapped by evil desires.
- 7 When a wicked man dies, hope perishes, and expectation of power comes to nothing.
- 8 A righteous person is delivered out of trouble, and the wicked takes his place.
- 9 With his mouth the godless man destroys his neighbor, but the righteous will be delivered through knowledge.
- 10 When it goes well with the righteous, the city rejoices. When the wicked perish, there

is shouting.

- 11 By the blessing of the upright, the city is exalted, but it is overthrown by the mouth of the wicked.
- 12 One who despises his neighbor is void of wisdom, but a man of understanding holds his peace.
- 13 One who brings gossip betrays a confidence, but one who is of a trustworthy spirit is one who keeps a secret.
- 14 Where there is no wise guidance, the nation falls, but in the multitude of counselors there is victory.
- 15 He who is collateral for a stranger will suffer for it, but he who refuses pledges of collateral is secure.
- 16 A gracious woman obtains honor, but violent men obtain riches.
- 17 The merciful man does good to his own soul, but he who is cruel troubles his own flesh.
- 18 Wicked people earn deceitful wages, but one who sows righteousness reaps a sure reward.
- 19 He who is truly righteous gets life. He who pursues evil gets death.
- 20 Those who are perverse in heart are an abomination to YHWH, but those whose ways are blameless are his delight.
- 21 Most certainly, the evil man will not be unpunished, but the seed of the righteous will be delivered.
- 22 Like a gold ring in a pig's snout, is a beautiful woman who lacks discretion.
- 23 The desire of the righteous is only good. The expectation of the wicked is wrath.
- 24 There is one who scatters, and increases yet more. There is one who withholds more than is appropriate, but gains poverty.
- 25 The liberal soul shall be made fat. He who waters shall be watered also himself.
- 26 People curse someone who withholds grain, but blessing will be on the head of him who sells it.
- 27 He who diligently seeks good seeks favor, but he who searches after evil, it shall come to him.
- 28 He who trusts in his riches will fall, but the righteous shall flourish as the green leaf.
- 29 He who troubles his own house shall inherit the wind. The foolish shall be servant to the wise of heart.
- 30 The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life. He who is wise wins souls.
- 31 Behold, the righteous shall be repaid in the earth; how much more the wicked and the sinner!
